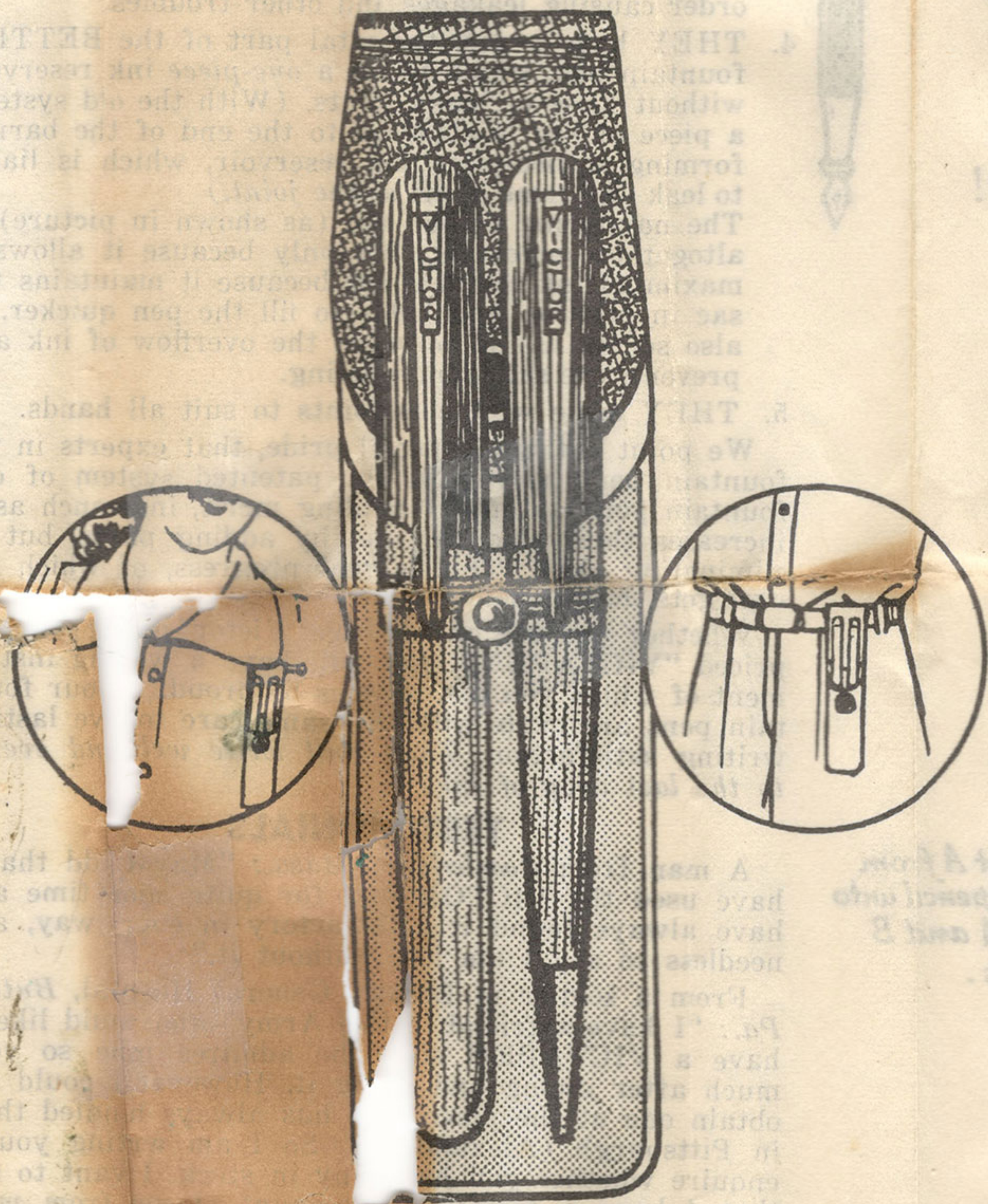

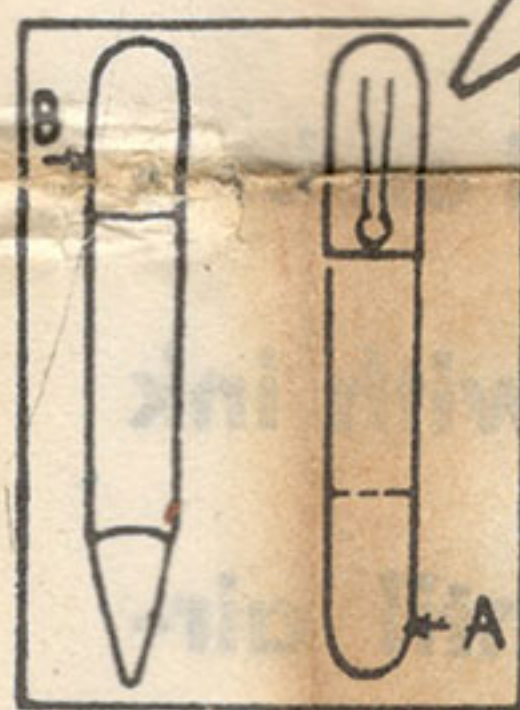

1. THEY fill "full" and let you know when they are completely filled. (See Illustration.)
2. THEY are of such simple construction, that repair troubles are practically eliminated.
3. THEY have no internal parts, such as levers, buttons, springs, pressure bars, pistons, cork packings, etc., which take up much room and get easily out of order causing leakages and other troubles.
4. THEY have a sac, the vital part of the BETTER fountain pen, which forms a *one-piece* ink reservoir without loose or leaky joints. (With the old system, a piece of sac is attached to the end of the barrel, forming a *two-piece* ink reservoir, which is liable to leak and come apart at the *joint*.)  
The narrowing of our sac (as shown in picture) is altogether important, not only because it allows a maximum ink storage, but because it maintains the sac in position and helps to fill the pen quicker. It also serves as aid to check the overflow of ink and prevents the sac from twisting.
5. THEY come with pen points to suit all hands.



We point out with special pride, that experts in the fountain pen art regard the patented system of our fountain pens as of outstanding merit, inasmuch as it increases their efficiency not by adding parts, but by eliminating them. This is real progress, of which the user gets the full benefit.
